Points earned: 1st Place = 5 points, 2nd = 4 points, 3rd = 3 points, 4th = 2 points, 5th= 1 point Any questions concerning rules and/or classes should be directed to the registration booth. Daily High Point Winners in: Western, English, Ranch, Games awarded at each show. Year end awards will be given for youth and adult exhibitors that accumulate the most points in their divisions (English, Western, Ranch, Games)

You must show in four(4) shows to qualify for year end awards.
